





Equilibrium for the Climate Change

DISTENDER is an EU-funded project to establish new common ground for scientists and policy makers by developing actionable strategies for climate change mitigation and adaptation processes.

The strategies will derive from measures to address climate change and impact. With a participatory approach, they will bring together scientists, businesses, governments and policy makers.

The holistic approach developed by the project will be tested through five Core Case studies across the EU against specific climate risks. In addition, the project has six case studies so-called Followers which will use the methodology to eventually apply it after the project. The DISTENDER methodology is expected to be used by thousands of villages at different scales in Europe.

As a key result, this integrated methodology would allow adaptation and mitigation strategies to be planned using scientific information produced by impact assessment models. The selected strategies will be robust to the local socioeconomic and climate scenarios developed in the project. To help stakeholders to select the right strategies, a DSS will be developed.
